spare time ... same as *free time*.

out of time ... no more time to do something.

make time ... find the time to do something.

kill time ... do something to pass the time.

time after time ... happens again and again.

time off ... to take a day or days off work.

in the nick of time ... to finish *just* before it's too late.

time is money ... your time is valuable.

time will tell ... we will know the answer in the future.

waste of time ... something is not worth doing.

behind the times ... something is old-fashioned.

a whale of a time ... to do something really fun.

the time is ripe ... a great time to do something.

two-time ... to lie, cheat, betray someone.

all in good time ... telling someone to be patient.

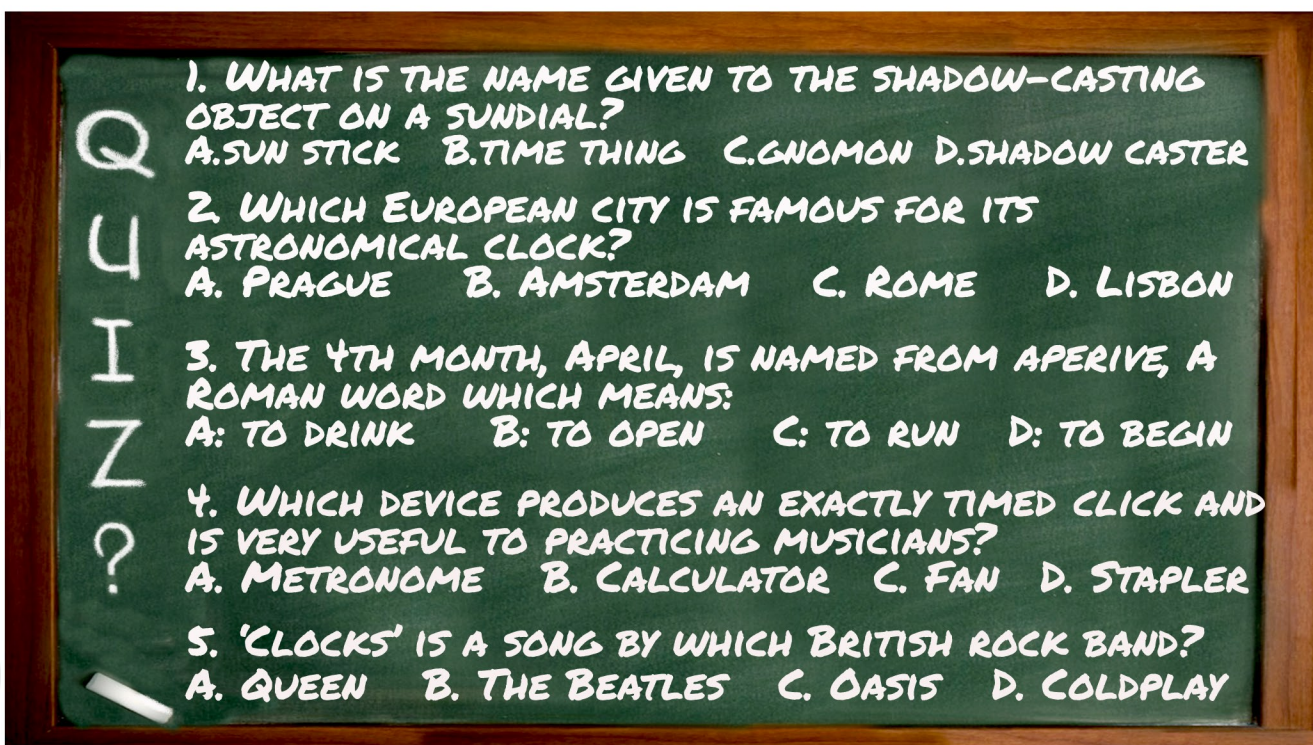
Read this passage and answer the questions below.
