GRAMMAR & PHRASES

As shop/shopping can be a noun and a verb, we need to be aware of the context in which it is used.

For example, "I went to the shop to go shopping, then after my shop, I took the shopping home."

to be on a tight budget - not much money to spend.

shop until you drop - go shopping until you are very tired.

to give the hard sell - sales clerk puts pressure on to buy.

splash out on 'x' - to buy something expensive

to go on a shopping spree - do lots of shopping.

take 'x' back - to return 'x' to the store for refund, etc.

to shop around - to check other stores for the best price.

rip-off - much more expensive than it should be.

to go bargain hunting - to look for good value shopping.

to be ripped off - paid much more than you should have.

to pick up a bargain - to make a good-value purchase.

window shopping - not buying, only looking around.

'x' *costs an arm and a leg* - x is very expensive.

out of stock - the store has no more of this product.

'x' *is as cheap as chips* - x is very cheap.

to shoplift - to steal products from a shop.


