## CONVERSATION

### very / not very / a little

We can use very/not very/a little to describe **how much** someone has a character trait.

He is **very** patient.

I'm **a little** selfish.

You're **not very** sensitive.

My brother is **very** ambitious.

### Negative Prefixes

By adding a negative prefix to the beginning of an adjective we can make it negative!

(Ex: not friendly = unfriendly)

Use the following prefixes to make the negative form of the character traits above:

**un- in- ir- dis- im-**
